## Discussion Guide



This discussion guide is for the workshop ***For Senders: Sexual Harassment, Abuse, and Assault on the Mission Field***. Here are a few questions for you to discuss after watching the one-hour workshop. As Amy said in the recording, “This isn’t how it’s supposed to be, so let’s do something about it!”

1. Did any statement or section stand out to you? If so, what was it?
2. Was there anything unexpected or that caught you by surprise? If so, what?
3. Sexual harassment, abuse, and assault are not limited to one area of the world. As you reflect on the top ten countries that were reported from the survey, what stood out to you? Did anything surprise you?
4. Why do you think people tend to downgrade their experiences?
5. What are the “two buckets” that the data highlighted? What’s unique about each bucket, or, in other words, how are they different?
6. When it comes to frequency of sexual harassment, abuse, and assault on the field, what is the difference between a dog bite and mosquito bites? What reaction do you have to the results that were shared?
7. As a sender, what are the two things mentioned in the workshop you can do when someone shares their experience with you?
8. Thinking about organizations, churches, and friends or family, share one or two unique roles for each group.
9. What action can you take or are you motivated to take after watching this workshop?
